
# GEOPARQUES Spanish Forum





THE 2022 ACTION PLAN OF THE SPANISH GEOPARKS FORUM IN THE FRAMEWORK OF THE GGN STRATEGY







The Spanish Geoparks Forum gathers the members of the GGN in Spain, the UGGps and the individual members.

**Cooperation**, as a hallmark of the UNESCO Global Geoparks, is a growing fact in Spain. Its progression and its ability to interact with the Spanish society and the public administrations facilitate the visibility, conservation and sustainable development of its territories.

That requires a higher level of organization and simplest and better procedures for contracting common external services. For those reasons and the aforementioned experience, the extraordinary session of the Spanish Geoparks Forum, held on December 9, 2021, decided to propose the creation of a national non-profit Association with the name of Spanish Geoparks Forum, within the framework of the Global Geoparks Network.

The **Spanish Geoparks Forum** coexist with the **Spanish Geoparks National Committee**. This last is a chartered body chaired by the **UNESCO Spanish National Commission** and includes the UGGps, representatives of the Spanish Government, the Governments of the Autonomous Communities with geoparks, and from the IGSP.



Different activities constitute the elements of cooperation in the Forum:

- Promote and disseminate the activity of the UNESCO Global Geoparks in Spain, in its cultural and scientific aspects, as well as its applications
  to territorial development, through common tools such as the web and social networks, open meetings and seminars, publications and others.
- Participate in scientific, tourist, educational or sustainable development meetings in which information or participation of the UNESCO Global Geoparks is required.
- Serve as a framework for the coordination of common initiatives of the Spanish UNESCO Global Geoparks, favoring their development and promoting relations between their members through the organization of common events and projects.
- Participate in the activities of the GGN and the European Geoparks Network (EGN) in accordance with their respective statutes and regulations.
- Participate in the Spanish National Committee for UNESCO Global Geoparks, dependent on the Spanish National Commission for Cooperation with UNESCO (Spanish Ministry of Foreign Affairs) in order to work into the Spanish contribution to the UNESCO International Geosciencies and Geoparks Program.



During the SGF meeting on May 5, this year, a document explaining the 2021 activities in the framework of the GGN Strategy 2022-2023 was analysed. Even if many of the GGN proposed strategic actions have elements in common, it was considered important to have a presentation about the concordance between the 2022 Action Plan of the Spanish Geoparks Forum and the GGN Strategy.

Hope this presentation help to visibilize the contribution of the Spanish Geoparks to the UNESCO Program and to the GGN development.



## Forum Functioning and Communication with the Forum members

For the general coordination and the communication among the SGF members, the current structures and tools are:

- Coordination team: Coordinator: José Mª Barrera (Villuercas-Ibores-Jara UGGp), Vice-coordinator: Karmah Salman (Las Loras UGGp); Secretary: Antonio García (Sierras Subbéticas UGGp). The coordination team have regular online meetings and whatsapp group to prepare the Forum meetings and the activities.

#### PROCEDIMIENTO PARA LA PRIORIZACIÓN DE CANDIDATURAS ESPAÑOLAS A GEOPAROUE MUNDIAL DE LA UNESCO

MARZO 202

Antecedentes y justificación:

Los geoparques mundiales de la UNESCO, incluidos en el Programa Internacional de Ciencias de la Tierra y Geoparques (PICGG), indican en el punto 5.2 de sus estatutos que sólo pueden permanecer dos candidaturas por país y año para ser evaluadas. Por este motivo, en el seno del Comité Nacional Español de Geoparques (en adelante CNEG) se ha establecido este procedimiento mediante criterios de priorización que permitirá seleccionar de forma objetiva aquellas dos candidaturas españolas, en caso de concurrir un número mayor, para que puedan tener la carta de apoyo y ser sometidas a la evaluación del Programa.

- 1. Principios: Este procedimiento se construye sobre tres principios:
  - Respetar la competencia de la UNESCO para evaluar a los nuevos aspirantes a Geoparque Mundial y,
  - Garantizar, en la recomendación a la Comisión Nacional Española de Cooperación con la UNESCO, la solidez de los proyectos que España presenta al Programa.
  - Sólo se aplicará este procedimiento en el caso de concurrir más de dos aspirantes a Geoparque Mundial UNESCO cuyas candidaturas han sido evaluadas positivamente por el CNEG, o cuando se superen el número de dos si hay candidaturas españolas activas previas en UNESCO.
- 2. Candidaturas activas: Según el punto 5.2 de los estatutos del Programa, solo dos candidaturas pueden permanecer "activas" en cada Estado miembro al mismo tiempo<sup>1</sup>. Esto limita, de facto, las candidaturas a presentar anualmente a la UNESCO a un máximo de dos proyectos. En el caso de que se acumulen candidaturas de años precedentes, la prioridad se asignará a aquellas candidaturas que mejor cumplan con los criterios de priorización, independientemente de su fecha de presentación.
- Validez del procedimiento: El procedimiento tiene validez desde el año de su aprobación y
  publicación por el CNEG. Podrá ser modificado por el CNEG como consecuencia de las
  actualizaciones o cambios de los procedimientos de evaluación y revalidación en el
  Programa de Geogarques Mundiales de la UNESCO.

The GGN seeks financial stability, and is prepared to support big promotional activities which will support the image of Geoparks as territories of excellence in tourism and education.






