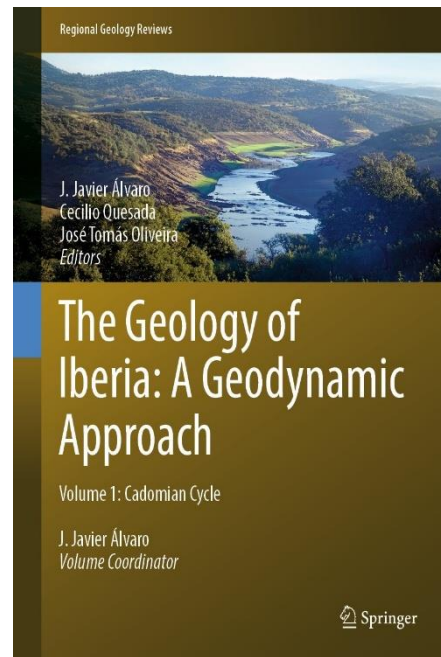


## INTERNATIONAL MEETING ON THE CADOMIAN OROGENY IN IBERIA

### Aim of the meeting

The scientific sessions will be focused on the orogenies related to the assembly of Gondwana, such as the Pan-African, Avalonian and Cadomian orogenies recorded in North Africa, eastern North America and western-central Europe across the Ediacaran-Terreneuvian. Contributions dealing with structural, magmatic, metamorphic, geochemical, palaeomagnetic and sedimentary frameworks, provenance sources, early shelly and microbial communities, and chronostratigraphic and radiometric constraints are particularly welcome.



### Preliminary meeting date and place

### *Post-conference fieldtrip* – September 29th to October 2nd, 2027

Visit to representative outcrops of the Ossa-Morena and Central Iberian zones in Portugal and Spain exhibiting Ediacaran to Terreneuvian magmatic, sedimentary and shelly palaeontological sites characteristic of the Cadomian orogeny and its final collapse.

A shuttle service will be provided at the beginning of the meeting and at the end of the fieldtrip, connecting Madrid–Barajas International Airport and Guadalupe.

Proceedings of the conference will be formally published in an international journal.
